Director's Report: The library is currently recruiting for a part time customer service/program position and part time summer position. Plans are to advertise for family literacy coordinator. Local history construction project is substantially complete and looks great. A family literacy success story dealing with parenting was highlighted. Tutor training is on the horizon.
